DATES AT A GLANCE		MESSAGE FROM ECSS ADMINISTRATION Dear Parents/Guardians,
Feb 1-28	<u>Black History</u> <u>Month</u>	This week in person learning will commence beginning on Tuesday, February 16, 2021 . We look forward to once again welcoming students back to Emily Carr. Please note there are additional COVID Screening Measures and Protocols outlined below:
Feb. 11-16	Semester One Report Cards sent home	 Step 1: Secondary students to complete on-line self-assessment <u>COVID-19 School and</u> <u>ChildCare Screening Tool</u> prior to entering the school on a daily basis. Step 2: Upon completion of the self-assessment, complete response to the question: "Have you completed the self-screening test?" in the Confirmation <u>Form</u>. Student receives an email response when they respond "Yes". Upon entering ECSS at assigned entrances (see below), student must provide confirmation of completion of the self-screening (email response) by way of: On phone – email or picture of email from their computer Hard copy print off of email. If neither option is available, they can provide verbal response confirming completion Supervising staff member checks with students upon entry. Students who indicate they "did not" complete the self-assessment are to be directed to the posted COVID-19 School and Child-Care Screening tool to review the questions and provide verbal response to staff member if "no" to all, direct to class, or if "yes" to any, direct to the designated isolation room for pickup and will be advised to attend an assessment center. Students who do not complete the self-assessment will not be able to enter ECSS. Students are discouraged from congregating before and after school. York Region Public Health is recommending that students wear <u>three-layer masks</u>. Two layer masks are permitted if they are clean and fit appropriately. Masks are now required outdoors, in addition to in-the school.





The chart below indicates which entrance your child is to use according to classroom number and the map identifies where the entrance is located.







We kindly ask that if you drive your child to school, please drop your child off close to his/her assigned entrance. If you child arrives by bus, please identify the assigned entrance on the above map and explain to your child where to enter/leave ECSS.

REMINDERS

We ask that parents/guardians regularly review the following reminders with your child(ren):
Effective immediately, all students are required to complete a York Region Public Health

- Effective immediately, all students are required to complete a <u>York Region Public Health</u> <u>school and child-care screening tool</u> before entering ECSS. Daily confirmation of screening will be required. Information above.
- Wear masks at all times. Masks are now required outdoors, as well as common areas, in addition to in-class. York Region Public Health is recommending that students wear <u>three-layer masks</u>. Two layer masks are permitted if they are clean and fit appropriately.
- Students are discouraged from congregating before and after school.
- Families dropping off and picking up their children at school are reminded to wear masks and not congregate while on school property.
- Use provided hand sanitizers entering/leaving classrooms and ECSS.
- Maintain physical distancing requirements of 2 meters.
- Follow directional floor decals in the halls and stairwells.
- Follow the maximum capacity signage and floor decals at washrooms.
- Please continue to reinforce hand hygiene practices.

 You will be asked for a password. The password is the birthdate of the student in the following format: YYYYMMDD where YYYY is the birth year, MM is the birth month and DD is the birth date. Please note if the birth month or date are single digits, please include a 0. For example, if a student has a birthdate of March 1, 2010, you would enter 20100301.
