We cannot accept any requests beyond this deadline, so that timetables may be finalized for Semester 2. Students must be logged into their GAPPS account to access the form. Guidance Counsellors will inform students via their GAPPS account if the request could or could not be fulfilled. Once again, it is important to reiterate that very few changes can be made based on course availability and cohorting.
