YRDSB EDUCATION CAREER VIRTUAL FAIR - Thursday, March 25, 2021

The Education Career Fair (ECF) event is a national initiative that provides grade 10 and 11 students with the opportunity to engage in pathway planning for one day with exhibitors from Ontario, national post-secondary institutions, career training institutions, Industry associations, local employers and volunteer/non-profit organizations.

The ECF event will support students to begin planning their future career path by participating in seminars, engaging in one-on-one discussions with school recruiters and industry experts, and reflecting on their experience and learning in their myPathway Planner.

Students must **register in advance** to participate in the virtual fair taking place Thursday, March 25, 2021. The day will provide new, dynamic and engaging experiences delivered virtually by the ECF in partnership with the YRDSB Pathways Team, Curriculum and

Instructional Services. Please refer to the attached letter for event details and registration information.

In addition, students are also eligible to pick up a "STUDENT LIFE EXPO IN A BOX" for

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FREE. This box includes viewbooks, brochures, promotional items, swag, and some giveaways. Every student will receive a unique code to get Microsoft 365, and be able to participate in a contest for a \$2,000 tuition prize, and a chance to win 1 of 3 surface laptops. Interested students can log into their GAPPS account and complete the Student Life Expo in a Box Form. There is a LIMITED SUPPLY OF BOXES which will be allocated on a first come first served basis. These boxes will be distributed in the cafeteria between 10:30 am - 11:00 am on Monday, March 29th (Cohort A) and Tuesday, March 30th (Cohort B). Please note that the form will close on Friday, March 26th, or sooner if all requests have been fulfilled.
