- Parking: We kindly ask that you or your guardian park in the south parking lot.
- Social Distancing: In order to support social distancing, a limited number of students/guardians will be allowed to enter the school at a time. Pylons will be placed in order to indicate and support social distancing.
- Entering the school: Front doors will be propped open and we ask that you use the provided hand sanitizer upon entering the school.
- Exiting the school: The back cafeteria door will be propped open and we kindly ask that you exit as soon as you receive your package in order to expedite the pick-up.
