SAFETY PROTOCOLS

We continue to ask for your continued support during the coming weeks in ensuring that our school community remains as safe as possible. Below you find new Health & Safety protocols for in person learning:

- A) **NEW SCREENING:** On a daily basis, students will need to complete an <u>online</u> <u>self-assessment</u> prior to entering the school. Upon completion of the self-assessment, students must complete the <u>Screening Confirmation</u> tool to display to ECSS staff. Students will be asked to confirm the completion of self-screening before entering class by way of: On phone email or picture of email from their computer OR hard copy print off of the confirmation email. If neither option is available, they can provide verbal response confirming completion.
- B) MASKING: Families are to ensure that their child is wearing an appropriate mask (ie. clean and well fitted) in order to enter the building. Also,
 - Remind your child that they must ensure that their mask covers their mouth and nose at all times in classrooms, washrooms, and hallways. The one exception is when they are eating on their lunch break.
 - Students who violate masking rules will be provided with remote learning options.

C) ADDITIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY MEASURES:

- Use provided hand sanitizers entering/leaving classrooms and ECSS
- Maintain physical distancing requirements
- Follow the maximum capacity signage and floor decals at washrooms

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Parents, guardians and families are encouraged to listen to the news and monitor the YRDSB social media feeds for information regarding Inclement Weather Days (IWD). This is how the York Region District School Board will communicate IWDs to families.

This year, due to the COVID-19 global pandemic, our Inclement Weather Day Procedure will be adjusted based on direction from York Region Public Health.

For the remainder of the 2021-2022 school year, in the event school bus transportation is cancelled, the following Inclement Weather Days Interim Procedures for Elementary and Secondary Schools during the pandemic will be in effect.

- All elementary and secondary schools will be closed to all students and staff.
- All student learning (elementary and secondary) will be remote and asynchronous.
- Office staff will mark all students using the attendance code of BC (Bad Weather / Bus Cancellation).
- Before and After (B&A) Care programs will not run.

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AFTER SCHOOL LITERACY PROGRAM

SEMESTER 2 COURSE CHANGE REQUESTS

Students were sent an email to their GAPPS account today which shared the link to the "Course Change Request Form". Requests can be submitted as of **Friday, February 4th until Tuesday, February 8th**. This Google form will close at 11:59p.m. on Tuesday, February 8th. Students must follow their timetables until they receive official confirmation that the course change was processed. Course change requests will only be processed if the request meets one of the following criteria and only if spaces permits:

- o compulsory course pathway change (i.e. academic/applied/college/university)
- o unsuccessful in a prerequisite course or missing a prerequisite course
- missing compulsory course or graduation/post-secondary course requirement
- incomplete timetable (e.g. not enough courses)

Course changes will not be made based on teacher or period preference. It is not always possible to fulfill course change requests as space is **very limited**, so we appreciate your patience and understanding.

COURSE SELECTIONS FOR 2022/2023

Course Selection Video Presentations will be shared with **Grade 9, 10, and 11 students** during their period 1 class beginning the week of February 7th. Students may begin LOCKING in their course selections on **Wednesday, February 16th at 9:00a.m.** and they will **CLOSE on Friday, February 25th at 4:00p.m.** New for this year, parents/guardians will have to approve Course Selections by way of email approval. More information and instructions will be shared with students. Counsellors will be visiting classes the week of February 14th to answer any questions. Course Counsulations with Subject Specialists will also occur the week of February 14th. **Grade 12 potential graduates** will be receiving information about the EXIT SURVEY they must complete in their Potential Graduate Google Classroom. This must be submitted by **Friday, February 25th, at 4:00p.m.**
