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## MASKS:

Recently some students have developed the habit of not bringing a mask to school with them. We are able to provide a mask to a student whose mask is damaged or forgotten on occasion but not as a daily practice as our supply of masks is limited. Please ensure your child arrives at school with multiple masks as some may break or become damaged. Masks must be worn daily and in a way that covers a student's mouth and nose at all times inside the building.

## OSSLT:

The Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test which will be taking place twice this year. Grade 12s who are graduating are exempt from the test this year. All grade 11s and non-graduating grade 12s will be writing the test this Fall (date to be finalized). All eligible grade 10s will write the test in the Spring. ## TAKE OUR KIDS TO WORK DAY (TOKW):

<u>"Take Our Kids to Work"</u> (TOKW), a national initiative providing grade 9 students with the opportunity to observe a work environment or engage in pathways planning for one day. On this date, grade 9 students can participate in either a virtual/in-person job shadow opportunity or virtual activities planned by the YRDSB Pathways Team, Curriculum and Instructional Services and The Learning Partnership. Potential Graduates applying to the Ontario University Application Centre (OUAC) will receive their Personalized Identification Number (PIN) on Friday, October 22nd to their GAPPS account. Students are encouraged to reference the *University Application Guide* found under the topic "How to Apply to an Ontario University" found in their 2021/2022 ECSS Potential Graduate Google Classroom. Details on in-person (October 25th) and remote drop-in (October 27th) sessions have also been shared. Students can also schedule a guidance appointment for individual support.

All potential graduates received their **Personal Identification Numbers (PINS)** and **Ontario Education Numbers (OEN)** through their GAPPS accounts on October 22nd to support them with their OUAC and/or OCAS application.
