

We hope that this report will provide valuable feedback for your child while supporting conversations about learning at home.



OSSLT(LITERACY GRADUATE REQUIREMENT)

In a recent memo, the Ministry of Education indicated that the literacy graduation requirement will be waived for all students graduating during the 2020-21 school year. The Ministry is continuing to explore a field test of the online OSSLT in Spring 2021, which could allow the opportunity for non-graduating students to write the test and have successful attempts counted on their transcript. Further instructions on next steps regarding the online OSSLT in Spring 2021 will be forthcoming.

UNIVERSITY APPLICATIONS

Students may now begin applying to Ontario universities through the Ontario University Application Centre (OUAC). Personal Identification Numbers (PINS) required to apply have been sent to GAPPS accounts. A step-by-step instruction guide and pre-recorded tutorial on *How to Apply to University* is now available in the ECSS Potential Graduate Google Classroom. Students are encouraged to view the tutorial, follow the instructions on the guide, and then schedule a Guidance Appointment with their counsellor if they require additional support. The deadline date for university applications is Friday, January 15, 2021.

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
