The scholarship is tenable only at the University of Toronto.	The school will receive a National Book Award to present to the student on behalf of the University of Toronto. This award is available for undergraduate study at specific universities.	Value: Renewable for up to four years, it includes an annual tuition waiver and a stipend of \$8,000.
