## **HEALTH AND SAFETY**

We would like to thank you for your continued patience and understanding as we navigate through the pandemic. As a reminder, on a daily basis, parents/guardians of students under 18 and students over 18 are responsible to review and adhere to the <a href="COVID-19 School and Child-Care Screening Tool">COVID-19 School and Child-Care Screening Tool</a> (please click on Check for Symptoms Daily), prior to entering the school daily. Below are some also important reminders to note:

- Note YRT requires that student riders must wear a mask, though yellow school buses are mask-optional.
- Household and non-household close contacts of a COVID-19 case or symptomatic individual (even if not required to isolate as per the requirements in the screening tool) must self-monitor and wear a well-fitted mask (type non-specified) for 10 days (from last exposure) in school and child care settings.
