# MESSAGE FROM ADMINISTRATION

Dear Parents/Guardians,

This week we had the pleasure of welcoming students back to Emily Carr. It was great to see our students back in the building and by all accounts, our students have successfully transitioned back. As a reminder, Families who would like to have their child continue with hybrid/remote learning until the end of **Semester One** are asked to complete this Google Form. We will ask families to communicate their preference of learning model, face-to-face or hybrid, for Semester Two in the next Parent e-Bulletin.

We continue to ask for your continued support during the coming weeks in ensuring that our school community remains as safe as possible. Below you find new Health & Safety protocols for in person learning:

- A) **NEW SCREENING:** On a daily basis, students will need to complete an online self-assessment prior to entering the school. Upon completion of the self-assessment, students must complete the **Screening Confirmation** tool to display to ECSS staff. Students will be asked to confirm the completion of self-screening before entering class by way of: On phone – email or picture of email from their computer OR hard copy print off of the confirmation email. If neither option is available, they can provide verbal response confirming completion.
- B) MASKING: Families are to ensure that their child is wearing an appropriate mask (ie. clean and well fitted) in order to enter the building. Also,
  - Remind your child that they must ensure that their mask covers their mouth and nose at all times in classrooms, washrooms, and hallways. The one exception is when they are eating on their lunch break.
  - Students who violate masking rules will be provided with remote learning options.

# C) ADDITIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY MEASURES:

- Use provided hand sanitizers entering/leaving classrooms and ECSS
- Maintain physical distancing requirements
- Follow the maximum capacity signage and floor decals at washrooms

# POTENTIAL CLASS AND SCHOOL CLOSURES

As staff members and students are required to self-isolate with increased cases of COVID-19, schools may encounter operational challenges. Please be aware that there may be occasions when classrooms or schools are required to close to in-person learning and move to virtual learning for a period of time. Schools will notify families as soon as possible when this is the case. Families are asked to develop a routine of checking email regularly at the start and end of every day for important communication from the school and Board given our circumstances.

# AFTER SCHOOL LITERACY PROGRAM

The Ministry of Education has provided special funding for After School Literacy programs for students in Grades 7 to 12 to reinforce their reading and writing skills. The goal of this program is to build upon the reading and writing skills of students. Emily Carr Secondary School will be offering this program, with a focus on preparing for the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test (OSSLT), twice a week beginning February 15 and ending March 24.

# **CULMINATING TASKS/CREDIT SALVAGING**

There are no formal exams during the 2021-22 school year. Instead, the days that would have traditionally been used for exams (January 26 through 31) will instead be reserved for culminating activities (e.g., presentations, performances, demonstrations, portfolios, conversations and conferencing) and credit salvaging to help a student complete credit requirements.

Each class is unique and teachers will create schedules, based on the dates noted, that best support student achievement. This may or may not include specific activities during the exam period. Teachers will communicate expectations for culminating days directly with students and families.

# Please note:

- Students attend classes **virtually** on Culminating Days unless otherwise communicated by the teacher.
- Students participating in culminating activities and/or credit salvaging may be asked to meet with their teacher at any point during the school day, even if it is outside of their regular class time.
- Students in Community Classes (ME & DD) attend classes, as usual, during the exam period.
