COVID PROTOCOL UPDATES

We have been notified that students, staff members and school visitors will no longer be required to wear masks in school beginning on March 21, 2022. Staff and students who prefer wearing a mask will be supported in doing so. Students, staff members and visitors should continue to review and adhere to the COVID-19 School and Child-Care Screening Tool (please click on Check for Symptoms Daily), prior to entering the school daily. The screening tool has been updated to reflect new isolation requirements.

- Staff and students will not be required to complete the screening confirmation form each day.
- · Students will no longer be required to remain in cohorts or to practice physical distancing.
- · This will include the cafeteria where students may choose to sit where they would like.

Kindly note: The ECSS library will no longer be an area for eating and will return to be used for studying purposes during lunch.



GOOD NEIGHBOUR POLICY

Our community partners have reached out to us with concerns about the deportment of students during and after the school hours.
