### **Principals Report 19:20**

#### 1. School Update

We have hired a Core French LTO (Long Term Occasional) teacher for the time being. Her name is Mrs. McDonald.

Testing for Grade 3 Cognitive Abilities Test will take place for our grade 3 students on Monday, November 30 and Tuesday, December 1. The Test will be administered for our grade 3 virtual students on Friday, December 4.

## 2. Math Learning and School Focus

This year, math learning will continue to be a focus for our school and for our system. The new Math Curriculum will form a focus at our staff meetings and this math learning will directly align with our school improvement plan.

Staff are beginning to use the methodology of Vertical math where small groups of randomly picked students work on problem solving at the vertical whiteboards. Working together in this fashion helps keep students on task, engaged and not afraid to make mistakes as work can be erased quickly and redone.

We are looking at purchasing new digital History textbooks and teacher resources for grades 7 and 8, upgrading the reading recovery booklist (this is done annually) and purchasing new core French resources.

### 3. Traffic Readjustments and Safe Routes to School

I have been working with the Safe and Active Routes to School officer, Plant, Facilities, School Council and our Superintendent to try and provide enhancements to the flow of traffic.
