### Minutes

- School Council meeting minutes from Mar 27, 2018 were accepted.
- Agenda was sent late, to be sent on time going forward
- Conference call for next year to be setup to increase parent's participation
- Application for pro grant for next year is due June 5, 2018

  - Money was raised toward maker space in school. Several ideas were discussed such as: green screen for broadcasting overlay software, Beebot (140 each), Snap circuits, Makedo, Board games. Diana will investigate and come up with a plan for the September meeting.

- Administration going forward next year, discussion with Tod Dungey, Superintendent:
  - Mary Oppedisano is on Medical leave until the end of the year and is expectation that she is coming back in September. The board has to act based on information submitted by HR.
  - The board rules, in case of principal medical leave, is as follows: up to 2 weeks – internal coverage, over 2 weeks – board hire retired principal for that window. One of the challenges is the limit of days 50 days without impacting the retired principal’s pension. Therefore, Mr. Mainprize covered for 50 days and then Mr. Wagner covered the remainder of the year.
  - Parent stated that attention is needed for consistency the school. In this case, keeping Joanne as the VP allocation is important for the school. Mr. Dungey explained that the decision on VP assignment is dependent on funding and based on enrolment. The school will have a part time VP next year.
  - Parent stated that in the last two years, there were too many changes, with new principal, changes in VPs and the leave of the principal. This is not fair to the children and their well-being. Parents requested that Joanne stay in the school to maintain consistency.
  - Council thanked Joanne and Gord for their great contribution to the school.
