- Pizza kits-Marie to advise
  - o \$30/\$35 per kit for 3 pizza school received \$6 back. Decision: too expensive
- Cookie dough (Terra Cotta) \$15/40 cookies school receives \$6 back
  - o Grade 8s will be doing this
- Subs (January start) Marie presented to school, need to confirm day of the week and start day
