• Fundraisers run by School Council in 2022-23

Raised a total of \$40,000
Krispy Kreme: \$2000
Franklin Fête: \$4000
Pizza lunches: \$24,000

- What did the money raised contribute to our school community?
  - Technology (projectors): \$4000Basketball funnel nets: \$5000
  - Angel Fund to help cover fees for students in need: increased from \$500 to \$1000
  - Mats for primary: \$3000Grad contribution: \$500Sports equipment: \$3000

Lockers: \$2000Classroom fans: \$800

- Pending: Playhouse for Kindergarten area
- This leaves \$9000+ to spend at the beginning of the 2023-24 year
  - Need to examine if there is anything council should contribute to immediately
