- **Mental Health/Well Being** – School beautification \$4000– entrance painting, bunker painting, hallway signage, recess games/equipment for indoor/outdoor \$2500, outdoor storage, outdoor classroom \$2000

- Modern Learning – cost sharing \$6250, other \$1500

- Athletics/Clubs – supply teachers \$5200, gym mats for walls \$5000

- Student-Led Activities/projects – Me to We, clubs, etc. \$1000 - Grade 8 Graduation fund \$500

Projected total: \$43150 - \$27250 (council), \$20300 (school)
