Principal's report

- 1. Edsby is coming as a new communication tool with parents
 - a. More information is coming out Wednesday, November 1 via an email
 - b. There will be another email after that from the Board with information about how to set up your account
 - c. November 10 there will be another email to inform parents that sign-up for parent/teacher conferences or student-led conferences, open that day to the 22nd ahead of the time slots on the 23nd and 24nd
 - d. The next thing that we will move to with Edsby will be attendance, but that will not be happening yet; more details will come
- 2. Update to funds spent allocated June 2017
 - a. Spent for music, \$2000
 - b. Gym, \$1000 was set aside, but we were not clear on what that was intended for; looking for input. Does anyone recall what the focus of this money is for?
 - i. Discussed the motion
 - ii. Megan Morrow asked for a further \$1500 to go toward other
 - iii. Voted to put the \$1000 toward supply teachers
- 3. Wish list/fundraising plan
 - a. This list comes from staff who submitted items to admin for consideration by School Council
 - b. The items are all within the context of Math, Modern Learning, Mental Health
 - c. Sher suggested that we could bring in an outside organization to work with the students on something like martial arts, to improve physical fitness
 - d. The items are:
 - i. \$3000 for primary & junior book room, English and French,
 - ii. \$6000 for literacy and science: science kits
 - iii. \$3000 arts program
 - iv. \$1000 modern learning library resources
 - v. \$2500 kindergarten:
 - vi. \$6250 plus cost sharing:
 - vii. \$1000 outdoor play equipment,
 - viii. \$500 grade 8 grad
 - ix. \$1500 to send a second coach as needed
 - e. What are the priorities?
 - f. Questions about math manipulatives

- g. OPHEA has bronze, silver and gold levels for Healthy Schools; if you pick physical activity as the focus, then they will send equipment. Marlee is willing to work with our Healthy Schools person to get this happening
- h. Modern learning: focus on robotics, etc. in the library
