Mr. Edward will return to Hartman by February.  The holiday shop was a big success, a total of \$3606.40 was raised. The event was created by Hartman's Grade 6 students. The students decided to donate the donations to Sick Kids, The Water Project, Second Harvest Food Rescue, World Wildlife Fund, and Canadian Red Cross.  Girl's Inc. will run a lunch time program for grade 7 girls. The discussion will be based on healthy relationships, social dynamics, and such. 20 students per session, 6 weeks 1 hour per session during lunch time.
