PRINCIPAL REPORT

- Busing: Cost of busing has increased 3times need to use fund raising to subsidized
- Grade 8 Graduation:

 - o The principal will update the council on estimated expense.

 Graduation
- Pro Grant: Council is to put a proposal together featured around wellness. Idea of Game Night to be explored further.
- Parents have expressed interest in expanding the hot lunches program in addition to the current Pizza lunch on Mondays.
 - o Principal or staff to reach out to parents to enquire interest in volunteering during lunch to support the Hot Lunch initiative.
 - o East Side Mario's is recommended for Thursdays.
