Principal updates (Heather 30 min)

- 2) Gifted updates
 - Gifted classes capped at 25 for grade 4-6 and 27 students for grade 7 and 8.
 - Once the cap has been reached, students will be turned away to the gifted program at a different school. Priorities are determined on a first come first serve basis.
 - This year's screening Nov. 29-Dec. 3
- 3) Fundraising for charities: Terry Fox, Thornhill Church (Cash Online raised \$600 for the food bank) and Holiday Heroes (through the York Region Police with some gifts collected already including teenage gifts and new clothing).
 - KINDness initiatives This initiative will be extended over the winter break and culminate beyond the New Year. Our grade 8 students will be creating plans for different divisions in Henderson. The school plan will be shared during the next council meeting. Our school plan is an overall school plan for improvement focusing on mental health. Another area of focus is math and other learning. (School Improvement Plan for Student Achievement - SIPSA)
- 4) <u>De-streaming in high school</u> (video with information for parents)
- 5) Twitter feed to promote @Henderson_ave Please continue to join us to stay up to date to what is happening within our school.
- 6) Extra- curricular (Intra-curricular) some small groups are allowed to compete between a few schools until March.

 - Students who wish to participate will be required to show their proof of vaccination status.
