- Confirmed Performances: Chinese dance
- Performance being considered: Greek dance, Canadian & First Nations, Henderson band, Boostan Multicultural Collective JK & Sk dance, Tae kwon do by Master Chu, Free the Children presentation, international aid and outreach program to children around the world

<u>Treasurer's Report - Ms. Jessica L.</u>

- Funds Raised (Winter term) Sub Lunch had good results made over \$3,350
- Funds Spent (Winter term) Technology Cost Sharing \$3,300
- To date we have raised over \$12,000
- Carry over from prior years \$6,200
- There is more money available to be used for outdoor improvements
- Other possible uses: technology, Score board for gym, math games, outdoor games,

<u>Principal's Report - Mr. Alex Pancharovski</u>

- Henderson has been considered for a pilot to receive free metal umbrellas shades for JK/SK gated play area. Area being surveyed mid-April 2016, to be installed by September 2016. Maintenance costs @ \$300/year paid by School
- School buying more tricycles for JK & SK
- Applications for Math grants submitted for grades 1 2,3,4 (after school), and 5,6 (before school) targeted for at risk kids who need extra math help (determined by reviewing report cards). Will be run by paid school staff.
- Application for grant for Kindergarten Summer (JULY) program, (similar to building blocks). Literacy based.
- Conversation Club Starting March 7th for ESL students to run at lunch time. Target group are new immigrants. Run by Big Brothers & Sister of York Region
- Big Brother and Sister Starting April 8th. An after school recreation/mentoring program to start on Fridays for grade 3 & 4 students. Teaching social/cooperative sports/games. Limited to 20 kids.
- BMC Discovery Dance classes for JK/SK. Mondays after school: tentatively starting March 7th.
- All other programs still continuing no changes.
- Grade 8 end of year trip has almost 100% participation. High response has reduced costs by \$55. Now it's \$600 (+\$35 insurance).
- Grade 7 & 8 Mount St. Louis & Grade 4, 5, & 6 Snowy Valley Ski trip March 1st. Need Volunteers.

- Term 1 report cards went out this past week.
- New enrolments 3 new families to join Henderson in September
- Senior band performing at Marlies game on February 26th. Tickets sent home. 170 people from Henderson attending.

Out Door Improvement Committee Update

- SAC Board agreed to commit some of the carryover funds from previous years to the Outdoor Committee for outdoor improvements in phases. To be used in conjunction with the TD Grant.
