#### Treasurer's Report - Ms. Jessica Leung

- Raised Funds
  - o Sub Lunch had good results raised \$1,953
  - o QSP Magazine Orders raised \$733

- Available Funds to be allocated
  - o \$5,000
    - Music Alive Competition (May 15, 16 & 17) since the snack shop, which sold ministry approved snacks was originally intended and operated by teachers that wish to raise funds for this event is now closed, Mr. Pancharovski is asking for \$3,000 in total (\$500 already allocated plus \$2,500 extra) for 5 staff members

  - o There is an opportunity to rent Moana as a Pre-release for \$135, council voted against it. Will instead show a movie on the list that's already out.
  - o Movie choices will be given to students to vote on (Life of Pets, Finding Dory, etc.)
  - o Agnes purposes selling pop in place of water. Dorothy mentioned that Council has never sold pop in any of our previous events.

She will lead a committee to raise funds on a weekly basis to replace some of the lost in funds from the closure of the snack shop which was intended and still needed for the upcoming Music Competition
  - o Agnes is interested in doing monthly programs to teach students about nutrition during lunch hour. Mr. Pancharovski approves
  - o Snack Shop
    - no longer available

- A few primary parents mentioned that they support the snack shop as it was a misunderstanding and didn't know that all the snacks are ministry approved
