Several suggestions were provided to promote the school's fundraising. Golnaz will initiate this task and provide recommendations.

- a) Golnaz recommended that we mention that pizza and sub lunches are part of a school fundraiser so parents understand that they are supporting the school. Provide a tax receipt. Put message on neon signs at entrance of school.
- b) Lily suggested that in the book of forms, there should be a translated page explaining this and the message should be reiterated several times (multilevel marketing).
- c) Shirley suggested that it should be mentioned at the Holiday Concert.
- d) Jessica suggested that it should be mentioned at the Halloween dance.
- e) Dorothy recommended that communication should be between the parent and child.

Plan to go ahead with purchasing the scoreboard, but it does not have to be purchased until end of year, so amount allocated can be adjusted mid year depending on how much the school raises during the 4 area tournaments that we host. Alex will update council at the February meeting with regards to the sports funds raised to date then.

Will change from buddy bench to friendship fence, with extension of the kindergarten black fence.

<u>Principal's Report - Mr. Alex Pancharovski</u>

Reorganization Update: No additional staffing. Seventy to eighty students moved. Enrolment Total - 419

EQAO Analysis: There was a dip province wide and board wide. Individualized reports got sent home. Staff will be looking at detailed reports. Data (Henderson) indicates that girls feel they are not good math learners. Trying to shift culture in this area.

Focus will be on: Math and mental health. Math network with 4 schools to build capacity amongst staff and to share best practices. Planning on doing a family math night in January/February in order to discuss math strategies at school and how to show parents how to support.

Will look into the possibility of a primary choir
