Re: Class Placement for September 2017

You will note that your child's placement has not been included on the promotion letter.

The staff are working diligently to organize our classes to provide the best program for each child, and to comply with the maximum class size allowed.

While we understand that you may wish to know your child's class placement before the start of school, our enrolment may change significantly between now and the first day of school. Therefore, you will be informed of your child's class placement on their first day of attendance in September.

As part of our organization, we will have several straight grade classes and some combined grade classrooms. Combined classes group children from two consecutive grades (e.g., Grades 3 and 4) into one classroom. We do this for many reasons that include organizing classes to meet school needs and combining grades to balance class size. For more information about combined classrooms, visit www.edu.gov.on.ca.

Please note that there may be changes prior to the end of September 2017 (class sizes will be reported to the Ministry of Education). We will keep you informed of any changes to your child's class placement should the need arise.
