 - A) School update Cross Country today, 28 students going to Regionals
 - B) Fundraising Plan similar to last year (see sheet distributed by Sheila); focus is through the SIPSA; see list for further detail; part of Modern Learning, spent money for about 30 chrome books etc; part of Equity and Wellbeing Community is a work in progress as currently resources are in class pods and trying to get into a classroom space
 - C) Spirit Wear will have new 10th Anniversary logo; forms will be coming out to community soon
 - D) <u>EQAO</u> accessible online to public; school looks at 4 areas (Achievement, Contextual/demographic, Perception, and School Programs/ Processes Data); school staff look at the 4 areas of data and how to move forward
