- X English Destreamed or Locally Developed
- X French Academic or Open
- X Geography Destreamed
- X Math Destreamed or Locally Developed.

- X Science Destreamed or Locally Developed
- × plus 2 Elective Courses and 2 Alternates

GRADE 9 COURSES X There are no grade 9 applied course offerings.

- X Science, English and Math in Grade 10 are offered as an applied course type.
- X Grade 9 Open French should only be selected if you have had less than 600 hours of elementary core French instruction.

Academic

- X Academic courses develop students' knowledge and skills through the study of theory and abstract problems.
- X These courses focus on the essential concepts of a subject and explore related concepts as well.
- C They incorporate practical applications as appropriate.

Destreamed

- X Destreamed courses are comprised of a set of expectations that are appropriate for many students, and are designed to broaden students' knowledge and skills.
- X They are designed to increase flexibility in senior level courses, and ultimately, lead to greater pathway options following the completion of secondary school.

Open

- X Open courses, which are comprised of a set of expectations that are appropriate for all students, are designed to broaden students' knowledge and skills in subjects that reflect their interests and prepare them for active and rewarding participation in society.
- Control They are not designed with the specific requirements of university, college, or the workplace in mind.

Locally Developed

X Locally Developed course placements are determined in consultation with parents, Grade 8 teachers, and Special Education Resource Teachers.

WHAT SHOULD I CHOOSE?

- Families and students will select courses and may choose to collaborate with elementary school teachers, guidance counsellors, student success/support teachers and administrators.
- Students often choose a combination of course types to support different learning interests and styles.
- X Remember that initial decisions made in grade 8 are not "final" decisions. There are many pathways to initial post-secondary destinations.

SITE-SPECIFIC PROGRAMS AT HODAN NALAYEH SECONDARY SCHOOL

French Immersion (FI) Program

For students coming from an Elementary French Immersion program – courses end in "F" - for Grade 9: French, Geography, and various electives

Advanced Placement (AP)

AP courses start in Grade 11 - courses end in "E" -English, Math, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Computer Science

*If you take HFN1OF (Grade 9 Food and Nutrition), you cannot take HFN2OF (Grade 10 Food and Nutrition) as it will count as a repeat course.

FRENCH IMMERSION CERTIFICATE

You will need to complete 10 full courses where French is the language of instruction to earn your *French Immersion Certificate*.

In Grade 9, French Immersion students should be selecting:

- FIF1DE French Immersion French
- X CGC1W<u>F</u> Geography French Immersion

Grade 9 French Immersion students are also strongly encouraged to select 2 French Immersion electives (two of AVI10<u>F</u>, BEM10<u>F</u> and HFN10<u>F</u>) as well.

TECHNOLOGICAL EDUCATION

Students entering Grade 9 in September 2024 and after will be required to earn a **Grade 9** or **Grade 10** Technological Education credit as part of their Ontario Secondary School Diploma. At Hodan Nalayeh Secondary School, this includes:


WHY IS MYPATHWAYPLANNER NOT ALLOWING ME TO SUBMIT MY COURSES?

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


Submit your courses between February 13th and February 21st. Course selection sign-off sheets will not be collected. There will be an online parent/guardian approval process.






In My Pathway Planner (myBlueprint), once students submit their courses they are prompted with a **Send Approval Email** option. Once clicked, a parent or guardian's email address can be added.



After entering an email address and clicking **Send Approval Email**, the parent/guardian receives a course selection approval request email, including the student's course requests, alternate courses, issues with course submission, student comments, and course guidance messages, if any.




In the course selection approval request email, the parent/guardian has the option to **Approve** or **Reject** the student's selections by clicking a button or link in the email.

Approve Course Selections

Don't approve of these Course Selections? **Reject Request**. If you reject this request, please follow up with your school's guidance counsellor about next steps.

Students see a confirmation within their **High School Plan** indicating if their course selections have been approved or not by their parent/guardian.



IMPORTANT DATES

- Friday, January 31, 2025 Electronic transfer request forms must be received by the home secondary school from the home elementary school.
- Thursday, February 13, 2025 Students can begin locking in their course selection in myPathwayPlanner (myBlueprint).
- Friday, February 21, 2025 Due date for Course Selections to be SUBMITTED in myPathwayPlanner (myBlueprint) for all students attending YRDSB schools.

*Students will receive their Course Selection Verifications in March.
