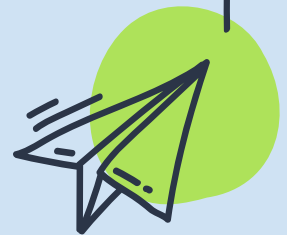

- X plus 2 Elective Courses and 2 Alternates



GRADE 9 COURSES

- ✗ There are no grade 9 applied course offerings.
- ✗ Science, English and Math in Grade 10 are offered as an applied course type.
- ✗ Grade 9 Open French should only be selected if you have had less than 600 hours of elementary core French instruction.



WHAT DO DIFFERENT COURSE TYPES MEAN?

Academic

- X Academic courses develop students' knowledge and skills through the study of theory and abstract problems.
- X These courses focus on the essential concepts of a subject and explore related concepts as well.
- X They incorporate practical applications as appropriate.



WHAT DO DIFFERENT COURSE TYPES MEAN?

Destreamed

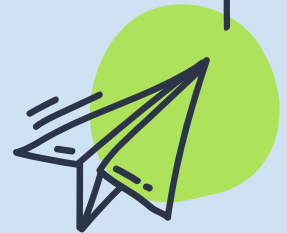
- X Destreamed courses are comprised of a set of expectations that are appropriate for many students, and are designed to broaden students' knowledge and skills.
- X They are designed to increase flexibility in senior level courses, and ultimately, with pathway options following the completion of secondary school.



WHAT DO DIFFERENT COURSE TYPES MEAN?

Open

- X Open courses, which are comprised of a set of expectations that are appropriate for all students, are designed to broaden students' knowledge and skills in subjects that reflect their interests and prepare them for active and rewarding participation in society.
- X They are not designed with the specific requirements of university, college, or the workplace in mind.



WHAT DO DIFFERENT COURSE TYPES MEAN?

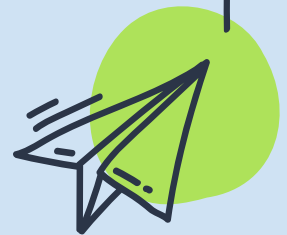
Locally Developed

- X Locally Developed course placements are determined in consultation with parents, Grade 8 teachers, and Special Education Resource Teachers.



WHAT SHOULD I CHOOSE?

- X Families and students will select courses and may choose to collaborate with elementary school teachers, guidance counsellors, student success/support teachers and administrators.
- X Students often choose a combination of course types to support different learning interests and styles.
- X Remember that initial decisions made in grade 8 are not “final” decisions. There are many pathways to initial post-secondary destinations.



SITE-SPECIFIC PROGRAMS AT HODAN NALAYEH SECONDARY SCHOOL

French Immersion (FI) Program

For students coming from an Elementary French Immersion program – courses end in “F” - for Grade 9: French, Geography, and various electives

Advanced Placement (AP)

AP courses start in Grade 11 - courses end in “E” - English, Math, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Computer Science

FRENCH IMMERSION CERTIFICATE

You will need to complete 10 full courses where French is the language of instruction to earn your ***French Immersion Certificate***.

In Grade 9, French Immersion students should be selecting:

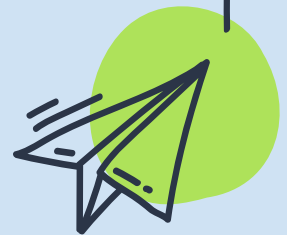
- X FIF1DE French Immersion French

Grade 9 French Immersion students are also strongly encouraged to select 2 French Immersion electives (two of AVI1OE, BEM1OE and HFN1OE) as well.

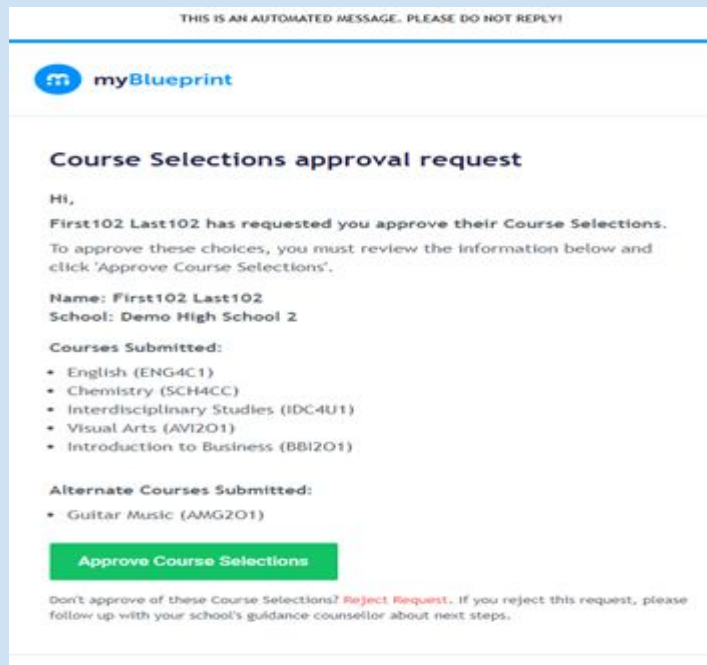
HOW DO I GET PARENT/GUARDIAN APPROVAL
FOR MY COURSE SELECTION?



In My Pathway Planner (myBlueprint), once students submit their courses they are prompted with a **Send Approval Email** option. Once clicked, a parent or guardian's email address can be added.

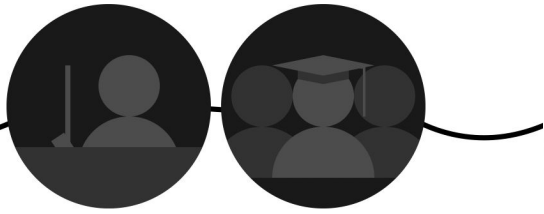
