## **Model Change Request Process**

On Monday, February 1, families received an email with the process to request an Elementary School Model Change. **Only families requesting a school model change need to complete the survey**. The survey (to switch models) will close on **Monday, February 8, at 7:00 p.m.** 

Please note that there will not be another opportunity to change program models this school year.

School Re-Opening (Face-to-Face) Letter from the Board - emailed to families February 3rd

Dear families.

We have received notice from the Ontario Ministry of Education that schools in York Region District School Board will reopen to students for in-person learning on February 16.

#### **Elementary Schools**

Elementary school students attending in-person should plan to attend school on **February 16**. Please check in with your before and after care program provider to confirm their reopening plans.

#### **Elementary Model Change Survey and Timelines**

For elementary students who are in the process of requesting a model change, they are to continue in their current model. Timelines for the model change will be shared in the coming week.

#### **Secondary Schools**

In class learning will resume on February 16. Your school will send details to confirm the rotation and cohort schedules.

#### **Virtual School**

There is no change in the schedule for virtual school students.

#### **Student Transportation**

Transportation schedules for students will be the same as the schedules followed September to December (before the school closures). Students who were attending school and transported during the closure period will revert to their schedule prior to school closure. ### **Health and Safety Measures**

As we have previously communicated, there are some new health and safety measures in place, including:

- Masks are now required for students in Grades 1-3, as well as those in Grades 4-12. Students in kindergarten are strongly encouraged to wear masks.
- Masks are now required outdoors, during recess as well as common areas, in addition to in-class.
- Students are discouraged from congregating before and after school.
- York Region Public Health is recommending that students wear <u>three-layer masks</u>. Two layer masks are permitted if they are clean and fit appropriately.
- In addition, **new screening measures** are required for all elementary and secondary staff, secondary school students and visitors. Details of the screening measures will be communicated as soon as they are finalized by public health.


