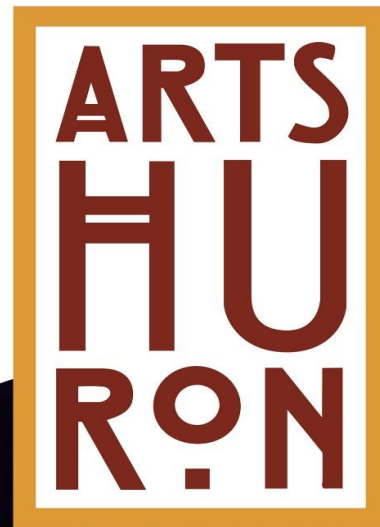


Arts Huron Information Night

Huron Heights is home to one of four regional Arts programs for students who want to immerse themselves in the Arts experience. Students are part of a comprehensive Arts community with workshops, field trips and showcase opportunities. Admission to the Arts Huron program at the Grade nine level is based on an application process. Students earn their certificates by successfully completing 8 Arts Huron Credits.

DANCE



- State of the art dance facilities and studios with sprung floors
- Multiple guest artists and dance workshops including African, Brazilian, Hip Hop
- Field Trips to dance performances and conferences
- Performance opportunities at Newmarket Theatre, The Greenhouse Theatre, Traveling Ensembles, Cause for Applause, Dances for a Small Space, Dance Showcase
- Students studies include performance, theory, history, technique and choreography



THEATRE



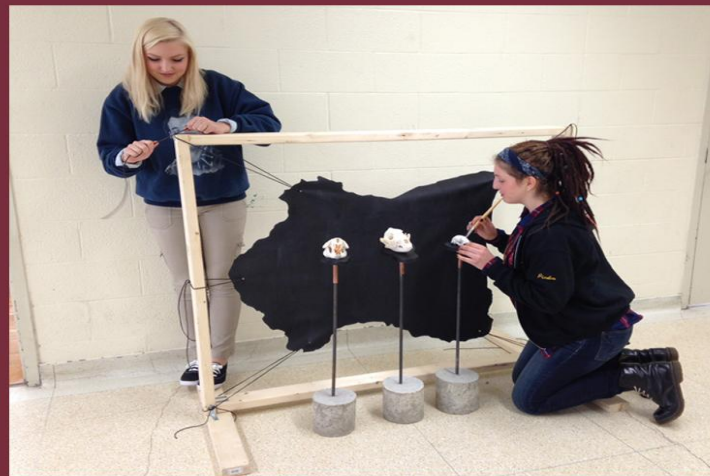
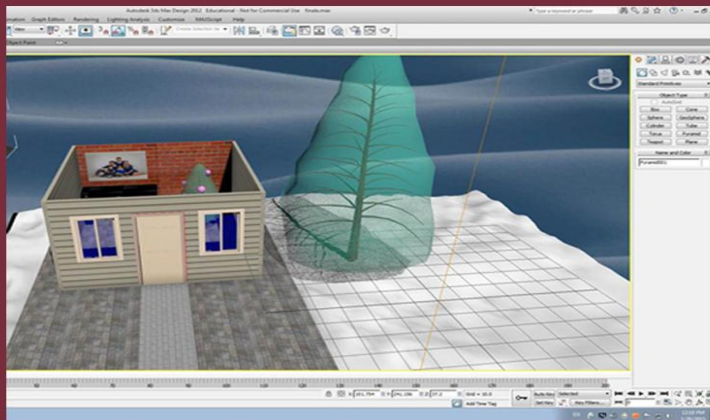
- State of the art Greenhouse Theatre.
- Black Box Drama studio with sprung floors and theatrical lighting.
- Multiple workshops including mask making, improv, prop making, playwriting, Shakespeare, and more!
- Theatre excursions to Shaw, Stratford and Mirvish Theatres
- Performance opportunities include the Mainstage Show, Studio Cabaret (semester 1 Performance exams), Huron Fringe student play festival, Production class plays, and Theatre Arts Guild Festival
- Areas of instruction include acting, playwriting, technical theatre, directing, stage management, design

MUSIC



- ❑ Three streams: Guitar, Instrumental and Vocal
- ❑ Instrumental and Vocal students have one additional performance **repertoire** class (Band or Choir) each year. Guitar students are encouraged to participate.
- ❑ Facilities include 4 music studios, practice rooms, a computer music Mac lab.
- ❑ Performance opportunities include our annual winter and spring concerts at Flato Markham Theatre, as well as several festivals, competitions and local performances.
- ❑ Guests artists, workshops, field trips to concerts, operas, musicals, and more.
- ❑ Opportunities to travel through Canada and abroad.
- ❑ Studies include performance, history, theory, music creation and songwriting.

VISUAL ARTS



- Unparalleled facilities - two large traditional studios, Digital Photography lab, Lighting Studio, & Digital Animation lab.
- Students benefit from regular guest artists and workshops
- Field trips include AGO, Ryerson, McMichael Art Gallery and the Annual OCAD graduate show.
- Opportunities for students to exhibit art work including the Newmarket Studio Tour, The Senior Show, The Newmarket Town Show, the Sharon Temple Art Show, our annual Art Bazaar
- Studies include technique, theory, art history, curation, & criticism.

Admission Process

- ❑ Students must apply to the Arts Huron Program.
- ❑ Applications available on the Huron Heights website under the ARTS HURON tab (information only no other materials)
- ❑ There is a \$20 fee to apply
- ❑ Applications are due **December 1st at 4pm**
- ❑ Once Students have applied they will be sent information about the admission workshops and in some cases, an admission interview
- ❑ Offers of admission will be sent out by
Monday February 5th, 2024.

Admission Process

- Typically we accept 28 students per discipline
- The odds of admission vary greatly depending upon the number of applications received each year
- Students may apply to two disciplines but may only accept one offer of admission.
- Students may begin taking classes in multiple disciplines as early as grade 10.
- To earn the certificate, students must join the program by their grade 10 year.

In order to obtain an Arts Huron Certificate, students are required to meet the following criteria.

Arts Huron Certificate:
7 courses in Major
1 Arts course outside Major
(e.g., 7 *Dance*, 1 *Theatre*)

Students may begin taking courses in a second discipline as of grade 10

Students are able to meet these criteria while also fulfilling their High School graduation requirements.

- Where is the application?
 - The application can be found on the Huron Heights Website under the ARTS HURON tab
- What happens after the application?
 - Students will be invited to attend a workshop or workshop & interview at the end of January
- When is the deadline
 - Application deadline is December 1st, 2023
- Is there bussing?
 - Transportation may be provided for students who reside a significant distance from the school and have little access to public transportation
- How much does the program cost?
 - Program fees are \$150/year
- Where does this money go?
 - This money goes directly to support program needs (art supplies, special materials, guest speakers, workshops, subsidize field trips)
