 Citations are complete and correct Proofread your citations. A citation tool does <u>not always provide the correct citations</u>. All citations properly constructed according to MLA style.
Citations match In-Text CitationsAll citations in the Works Cited list have a matching in-text citation in your assignment.
Works Cited page is a <u>separate</u> and the <u>last page</u> of your assignment.
