Vocabulary – French, English, History, Geography, Science...

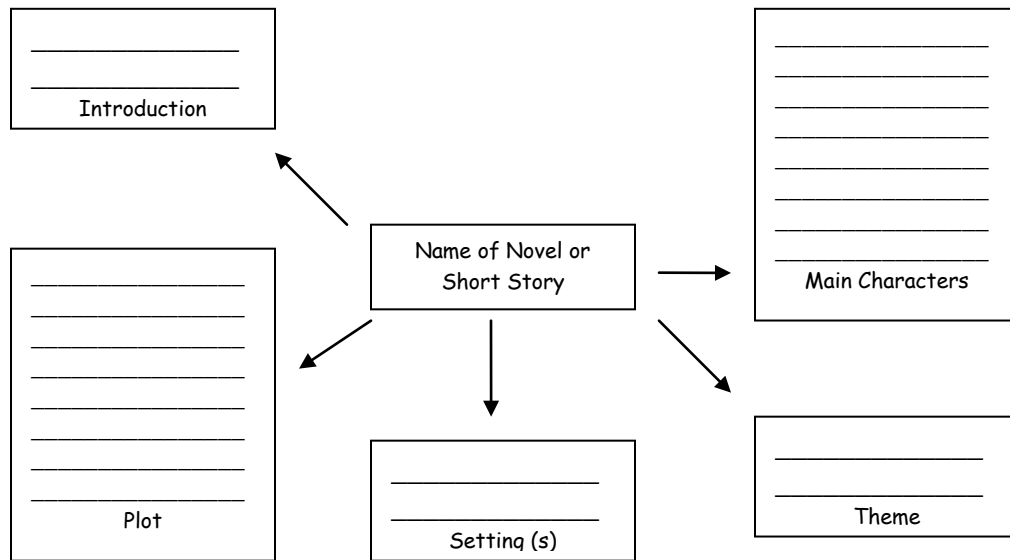
- Create a chart of the vocabulary with the words and their meanings in two columns. Use your own words!!!

Maps and Diagrams

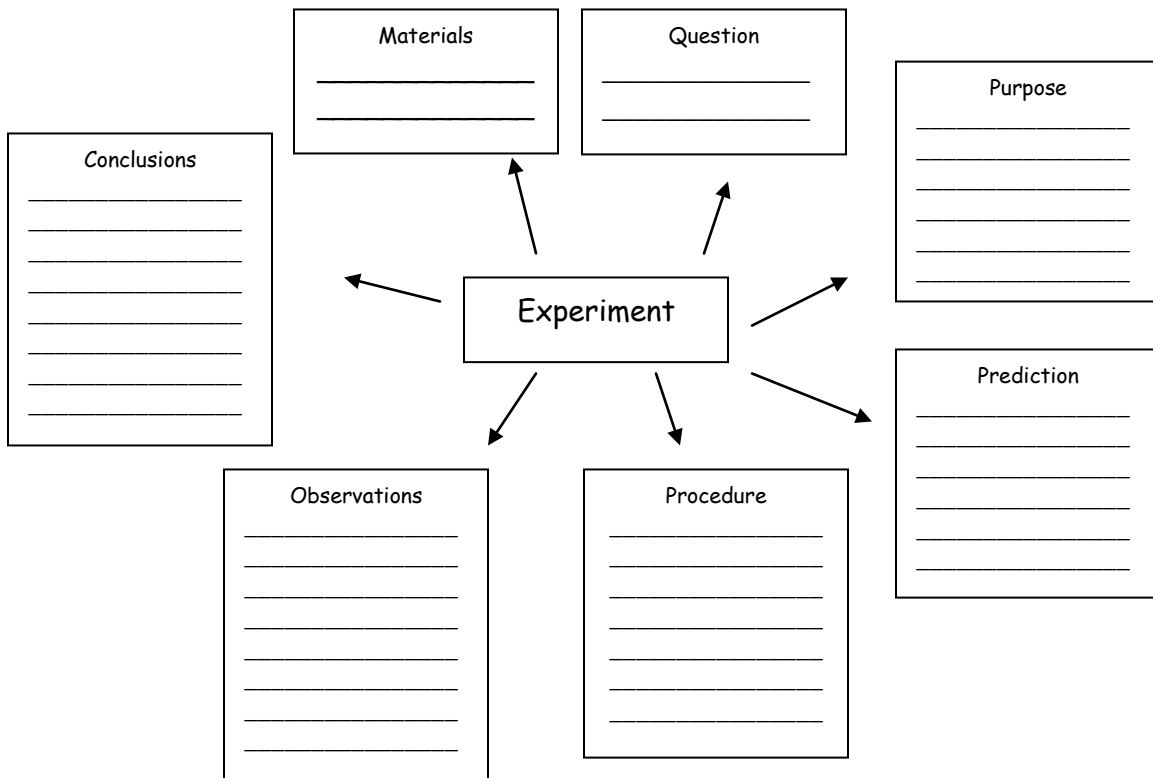
- Photocopy the map or diagram and then erase the labels. Label it yourself! Make it a game!
