  - Item needed: \$2500 for water fountain by the gym (not covered by Physical Plant)
  - C. Lamy to look into if this can be an item purchased with SGF's.

- 9. Pro-Grant Laura/Danielle
  - Application proposal was submitted for a grant for a Mental Health and Well-Being and Dismantling Anti-Black Racism night (virtually). Ideas include:

    - Cooking with family favourite snacks and recipes
- 10. Tree Canada Grant (with Jeanette)
  - Applied for \$3500 for 2022 Grade 8 graduating class to plant 2 sugar maples to replace the big sugar maple by the playground
