- 2. Review and approval of minutes: Danielle B. approves, Heather seconds
- 3. Treasure's Report* (see Treasurer's Report Spreadsheet below for more details)
 - Received Flip Give Credit of \$737.04
 - \$4,500 available after playground funds are dispersed. Otherwise closing balance was \$48,750
 - \$4500 closing balance
 - Money will come out of account when the final bill comes for the playground
 - \$73 000 was the final cost of the playground
 - \$12 800 additional cost
 - Seems to be some discrepancy in final accounting

- Gillian Patrick (former Principal) and others are tracking down the discrepancy
- We are in line for 93 Chrome Books, arranged and paid for by the Superintendent, because we are unsure of the future of our funds
