Ramadan began at sunset on March 10, with special worship and prayers primarily starting on the following day, March 11. Ramadan ends on April 9 at sunset, followed by Eid-al-Fitr on April 10, when special worship and prayers occur. As many Muslim communities use a lunar calendar to establish the dates for Ramadan, the aforementioned dates are not fixed and are dependent on the sighting of the new moon.

Students who are fasting are encouraged to let our staff know. They are entitled to extra breaks from athletic activities and may wish to have an alternative location to spend time during lunch.

A prayer space is also available for students who wish to use it during the school day inside the library in room 2001F.
