Please Note: OCAS, including our Contact Centre, will be closed for the holidays from Monday, Dec. 25, 2023 to Monday, Jan. 1, 2024.

During the closure, all OCAS services will be available, and will continue to update reports daily. While their Contact Centre is closed, they will be monitoring applicant support inboxes for urgent inquiries.

To support college applicants leading up to the February 1 <u>Equal Consideration Date</u> (ECD) for <u>highly competitive programs</u>, they will be extending our Contact Centre hours to include evenings and weekends for January 2024.

#### Course Selections for 2024-2025:

The week of January 8 - 12, Guidance Counsellors will be visiting all grade 9, 10, 11 classrooms and returning grade 12's to discuss course selections for the 2024-2025 school year.

These classroom visits will ensure all students can access My Pathway Planner, discuss how to select their courses and considerations they should be making for pathway planning and Pre-requisite planning.
