#### **Literacy Test (OSSLT) - Ashley Lewington**

All Grade 10 students across the province write this test. Successful completion of the literacy test is one of the requirements to earn an Ontario Secondary School Diploma.

Eligible for 2021 - 2022 (Introductions to begin late November to early December). The new format is a computer based assessment that comprises two 60 minute sessions containing 33 questions in total. There are 31 questions in multiple choice format and 2 open-response questions.

Who needs to write the OSSLT? Students in Grade 10, 11 and students in Grade 12 who are not yet graduating. Note - Students graduating in 2022 are exempt and will be eligible to graduate without this requirement as per the Ministry of Education due to the pandemic.

New Online Format for the OSSLT - user friendly with features in place to help you be successful. You can try the online versions to familiarize yourself with the format and types of questions that you can expect.

For students with an IEP, there are further accessibility tools, speech to text assist, extra time provided, students can wear headphones as just a few examples depending on the needs of the student and your IEP requirements.
