

RETURNING STUDENTS

If you are planning on returning, please book an appointment with your guidance counsellor to discuss your plan. The course selection submission window opens **Thursday, February 13th**. The deadline to submit courses through My Pathway Planner for the 2025-2026 school year is **FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 21st**.

Students that are returning and picking Grade 12 courses should consider the following while choosing courses and picking pathways:

- Must select a minimum 3 courses and 1 alternate per semester.
- 34 Credit Threshold You need 30 credits to meet Ontario Secondary School Diploma graduation requirements. If needed, you may earn up to 34 credits within five years. While enrolled in your first four consecutive years of secondary school, you may go beyond 34 credits. If you are at 34 credits or more by June 2025 and wanting to take more courses, you will need to find those courses through options such as Adult Day School, Night School, Online Learning or Summer School. The 34 credit threshold does not apply to students with an Individual Education Plan (IEP).
- Admission to a University for degree programming requires a minimum of six Grade 12 U or M level courses. This is the same for degree programming at a College. Check specific prerequisite requirements for the program or post-secondary institution.
- The most commonly required courses for admission to College diploma programs are Grade 12 English (ENG4C), Grade 12 Math (MAP4C) and Grade 11 or 12 Sciences (SBI3C, SCH4C, SPH4C).
- College admission requirements can vary a great deal from college to college, even when the program titles are the same.

- Interested in apprenticeship? Look into 'Techniques' programs at a College or begin to look for an employer that would be willing to sign you on as an apprentice. It is recommended to take Grade 12 English (ENG4C) and Grade 12 Math (MAP4C) and consider the Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program (OYAP) - OYAP

Students and families are reminded that course and post-secondary pathways are changeable and flexible.. Should you have you have questions regarding pathways, it is recommended that you gather information from the following resources to help make an informed decision:
