Grade 9 Course Offerings

Compulsory Courses (Choose 1 from each Subject Area)

- English** ENL1W1 (De-streamed) ENG1L1 (Locally Developed)
- English as a 2nd Language*** ESLAO1 (Level 1) ESLBO1 (Level 2) ESLCO1 (Level 3) ESLDO1 (Level 4) ELSEO1 (Level 5)
- *Please pick two levels or if level 4 or 5, add your ESL course and ENL1W1
- Mathematics** MTH1W1 (De-streamed) MAT1L1 (Locally Developed)
- Science** SNC1W1 (De-streamed) SNC1L1 (Locally Developed)
- Geography** CGC1W1 (De-streamed)
- Health & Physical Education** PPL1O1 (Healthy Active Living - All-ed) PAF1O1 (Fitness – All-ed)
- French** FSF1D1 (Academic) FSF1O1 (Open) – Note: This course is limited to students who have less than 600 hours of instruction in French

Elective Courses (Choose 2)

- The Arts** ADA1O1 (Drama) AMI1O1 (Instrumental Music - Band) AMV1O1 (Music – Vocal/Choral) ATC1O1 (Dance) AVI1O1 (Visual Arts)
- Business Studies** BEM1O1 (Building the Entrepreneurial Mindset)
- Social Science** HIF1O1 (Exploring Family Studies)
- Technology Studies** TAS1O1 (Technology and the Skilled Trades)
- Learning Strategies** GLE1O1 (Learning Strategies 1: Skills for Success in Secondary School) *placement determined through an IPRC
- Unlimited Potential Math Program** GLE1O5 + MTH1W5 (Students with an IEP) GLS1O5 + MTH1W5 (Students without an IEP) – must be recommended by Grade 8 teacher

Choose 2 Alternates

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Ontario Secondary School Diploma requirements: 40 hours of community involvement, online learning requirement, a completed literacy requirement and 30 credits including:

- 19 compulsory credits
- a minimum of 11 optional credits
- 1 credit from Group 1 - 1 additional credit in English, or French*, or a Classical or International Language, or a Social Sciences and the Humanities, or Canadian and World Studies, or Guidance and Career education, or Co-operative Education**
- 1 credit from Group 2 - 1 additional credit in Health and Physical Education, or Business Studies, or the Arts (music, art, or drama), or French*, or Co-operative Education**
- 1 credit from Group 3 - 1 additional credit in Science (Grade 11 or 12), Computer Studies or Technological Education (Grades 9-12), French*, or Co-operative Education**

A maximum of 3 credits in English as a second language (ESL) may be counted towards the 4 compulsory credits in English, but the fourth must be a credit earned in a Grade 12 compulsory English course.

* A maximum of 2 credits in French.

**A maximum of 2 credits in Co-operative Education can count as compulsory credits; this may include up to four credits achieved through approved Dual Credit courses.
