Things You Need to Know

- You will be restricted to a maximum of 4 credits beyond the 30 required for the OSSD
- Repeating a course counts as one of these 4 credits if you are beyond the 4 years allocated
- An identified student is exempt from this restriction
- You may spread the 4 credits out over 2 semesters
- Should you wish to do more than 4 credits beyond the 30 required for graduation, you will be directed to Night school or e-learning opportunities

- A course can be deleted by clicking on the 3 dots and selecting "Delete"
- Leaving empty course boxes result in spares
- A blue info icon indicates information you should know about when choosing this course. Hover the cursor over the icon for important information

- A red issue icon also appears
- Hovering the cursor over the icon will give you a text box that explains the issue
- He needs to correct the issue before going to review
 - If the issue cannot be corrected, check with Guidance and proceed to Review
