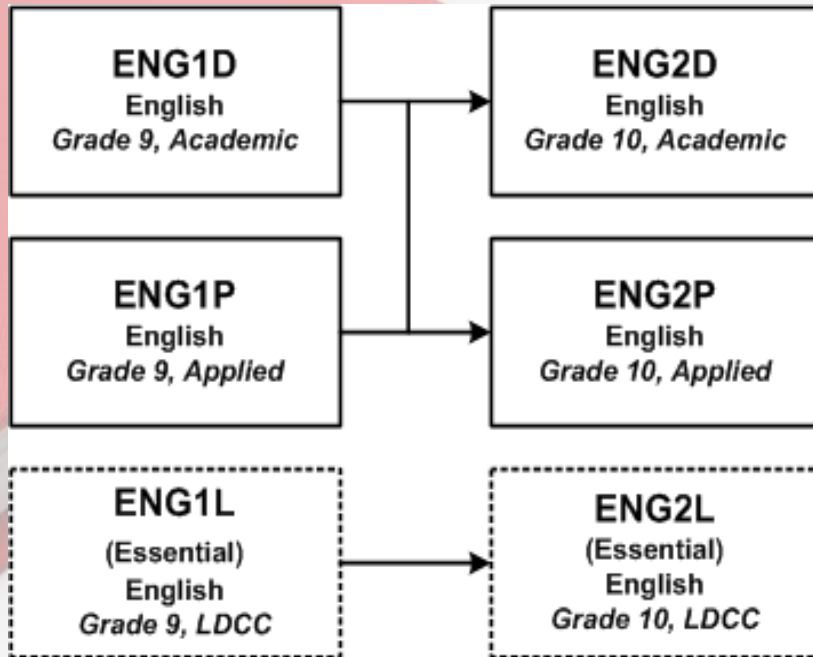

What part of the course code changes going from grade 9 to grade 10?

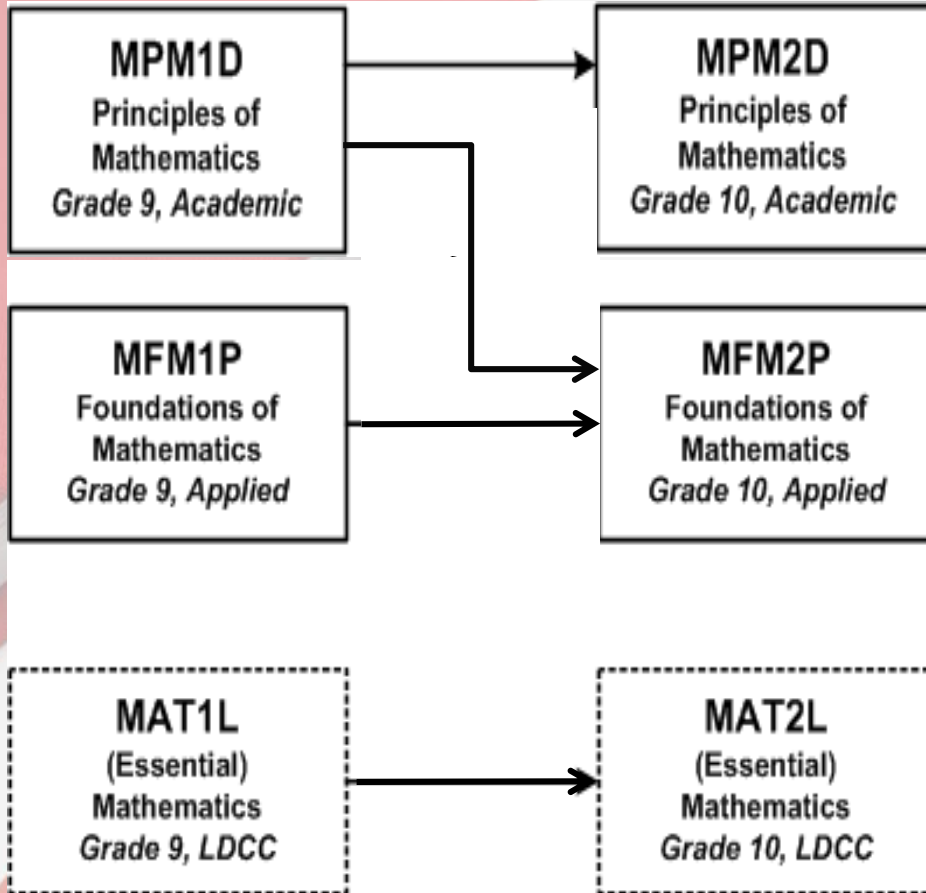
Notice how the arrows are joined going from grade 9 to grade 10.

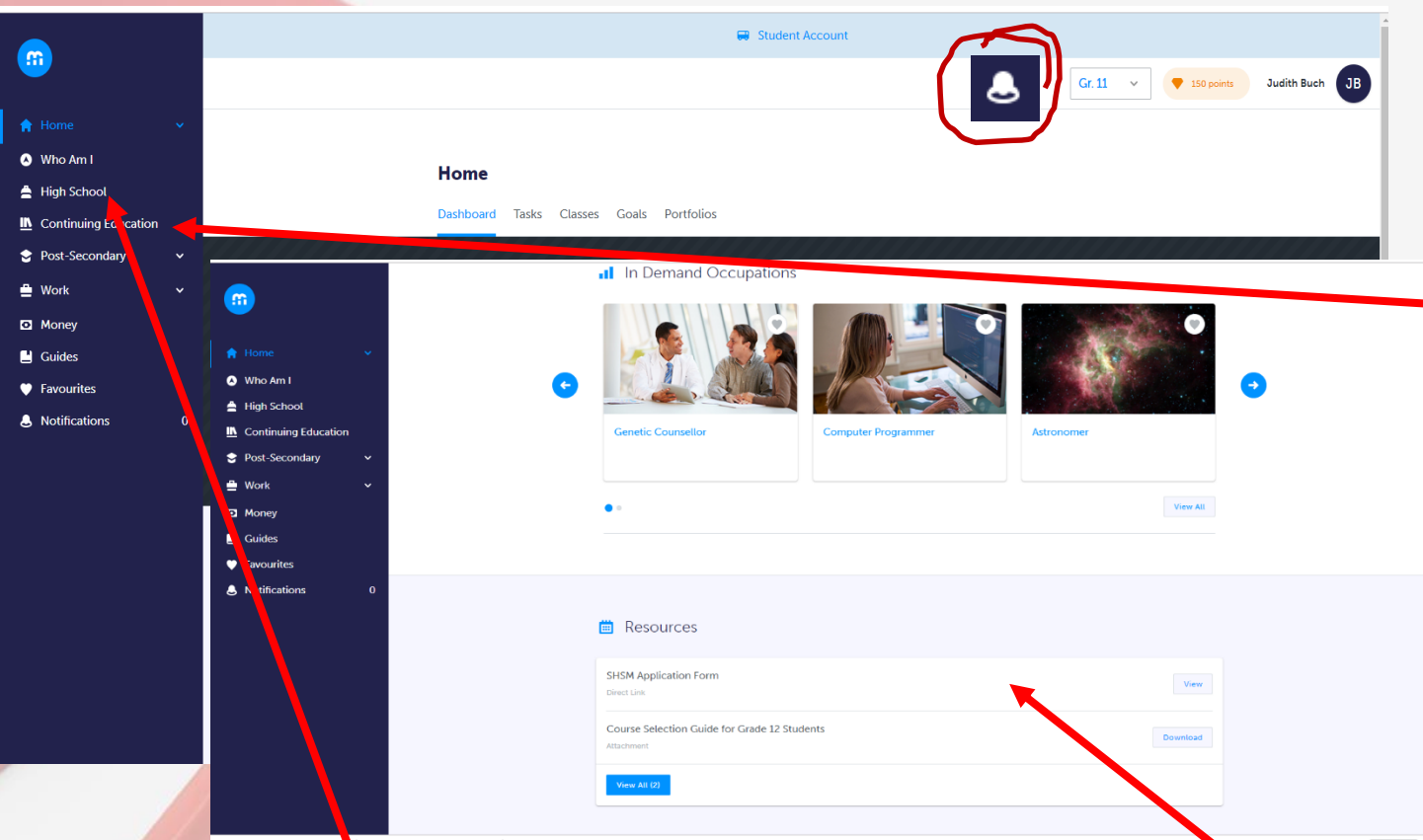

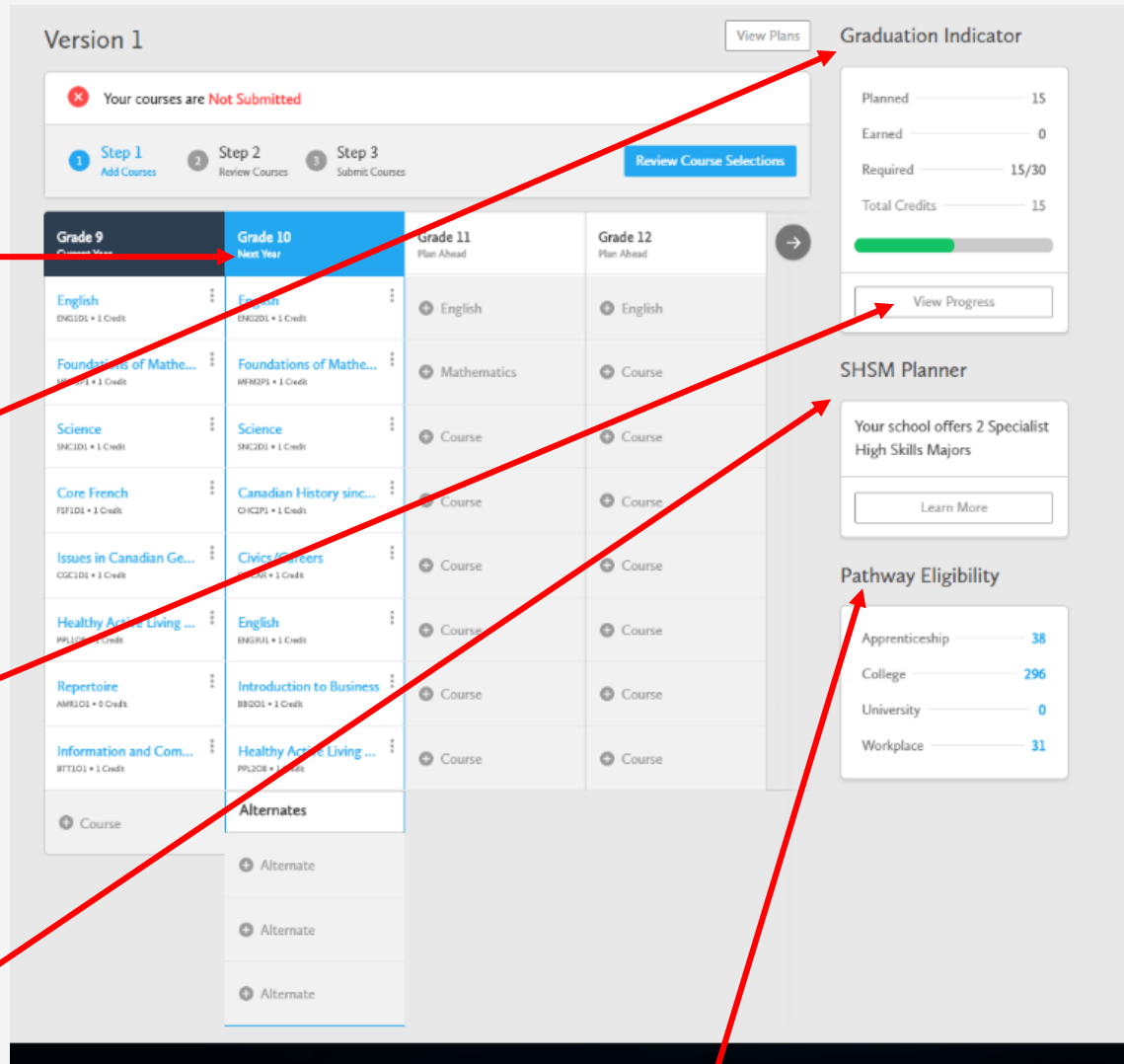
