### FINANCIAL LITERACY REQUIREMENT

Starting in September 2025, students must earn a new financial literacy graduation requirement as part of their compulsory Grade 10 Mathematics course.

Important to engage in early conversations with Grade 8 teachers if you are unsure about the appropriate course types to select.


Students Currently Attending a Non-YRDSB Elementary School (Ex. private school, Catholic Board, home schooled):




