

Notice: School Immunization for Grade 7 students

June 13, 2018

York Region Public Health is offering the following vaccines at no cost to all Grade 7 students this fall:

Vaccine	When is the school clinic?	
	Fall 2018	Spring 2019
Hepatitis B	Dose 1	Dose 2
Human Papillomavirus (HPV)		
Meningococcal A, C, Y, W-135 (required for school attendance)		Dose 1

Note: Hepatitis B and HPV vaccines are administered as two separate injections during the same visit.

What you need to do:



1. Read the enclosed information sheets and consent form. Complete and **sign** the consent form.



2. Return the **signed** consent form to York Region Public Health by **June 29, 2018**. **Do not return the consent form to your child's school.** You can send the consent form by:

3. If your child has been vaccinated, please call York Region Public Health at 1-877-464-9675, ext. 73456 to update your child's records.

Important:

Your child can still be vaccinated at other public health community immunization clinics if they miss their immunizations at school. If you have filed an exemption or do not consent to have your child vaccinated, please check "No" in the authorization section, complete and sign the consent form and return it to York Region Public Health using one of the above options.
