

The Literacy Committee is working to ensure our students feel well prepared for the test. Students writing the test met with our Literacy Teachers to register on the "KCSS Literacy Learning" Moodle in September. This Moodle is a one-stop-shop for at-home literacy test preparation. Students are highly encouraged to use the Moodle for practice and preparation for the test. Parents are encouraged to look at this Moodle with their students and to support their practice while at home. In September, students wrote an online practice test. This provided a sample of their

20th. Students will be participating in a series of six lessons focusing on areas of the test that students have traditionally found challenging. This will include: writing a series of paragraphs expressing an opinion, writing an objective news report, writing short open response questions, and examining graphic texts. Throughout these lessons, students will focus on topic development, making connections to the text, and identifying inferred information.
