OSSLT - April 10, 2018

Grade 10 students began the final phase of OSSLT preparation last week. There will be six in-class sessions that focus on areas that students have found challenging on previous tests, as well as two information sessions before the test. Please see the calendar below for details.

Students were provided with a booklet of sample questions and tips for the test. They also received a second booklet with space to answer the sample questions, rubrics used by the markers, and examples of previous student responses. Students will be focusing on various portions of the booklets in class, but are encouraged to use the remaining materials to practice at home. If students prefer to leave their booklets at school, they can access on-line tasks on the EQAO website (<http://www.eqao.com/en/assessments/OSSLT/students/Pages/students.aspx>).

Students are also encouraged to use the "KCSS Literacy Learning" Moodle. Students can login with their usual KCSS username and password. All parts of the Literacy Test are covered on the Moodle and there are many interactive practice tasks.

Remember that the OSSLT is on April 10th. Attendance is essential. Students who have questions about the OSSLT should see Mrs. Morris in Student Success or Mrs. Littlejohn in the Library.

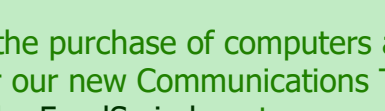
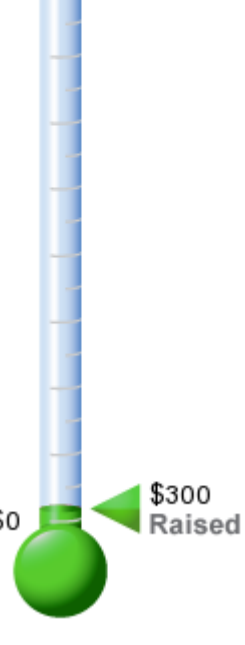
Contribute to Strategic Planning at YRDSB - Upcoming Town Halls

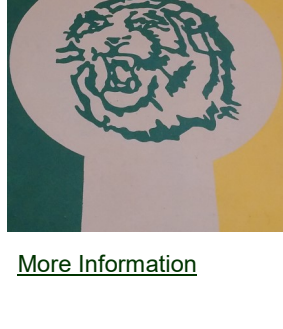
