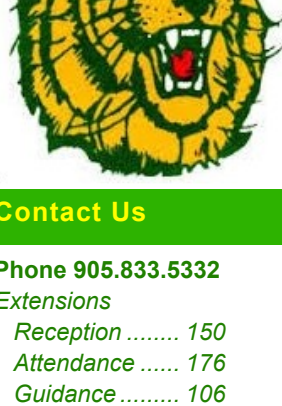
Why Code Aurora
