Learn about Developmental Services Ontario (DSO) and see if your child will be eligible for adult developmental services. By starting the application process early, as early as 16 years of age, you may be able to avoid service delays when they turn 18. DSO will help you determine the supports that are available in your area and that may meet your child's needs when they turn 18.


