Our second rotation in our Adaptive school model begins on Monday with cohort A for rotation 2 attending school in person. The morning in person class from rotation 1 becomes the first online block in the afternoon (12:20 - 1:10) and course two moves from the first online block to the in person block.

Cohorts for Rotation 2 & 6 - Cohorts for this rotation were emailed out to students and families on Wednesday. Just like rotation #1, if the section number of a course is 01 to 10, the student is in cohort A. If the section number is 51-60, the student is in cohort B.

Why new cohorts for each rotation? - Good question! Because our students have unique timetables, a student's cohort may change with the rotations. Cohorts from course one are not evenly distributed in the other courses. For instance, some course 2 classes will have 20 students from courses 1's cohort A and 10 from cohort B. This would not work with the Ministry of Education directive of cohorts of approximately 15. Therefore, cohorts must be adjusted for each rotation.

Credit International and Indigenous Languages (IIL) Classes Registration Open until <u>September 26</u>

The International and Indigenous Languages (IIL) program provides elementary and secondary students with the opportunity to speak, read and write a new language or maintain heritage language and culture. 



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




School News - reminder

COVID-19 SELF-ASSESSMENT

Before entering, please assess yourself:



In the last 14 days, have you, your child or other dependants:

Travelled outside of Canada, including the United States?

Had close contact with a confirmed or probable COVID-19 case?

Had close contact with a person with acute respiratory illness who has been outside Canada, including the United States?

IF YOU HAVE SYMPTOMS OR MAY HAVE BEEN EXPOSED TO COVID-19:

- Do not enter and return home immediately
- Seek assessment and testing as early as possible at a COVID-19 Assessment Centre
- Self-isolate for 14 days (including any members of your household or people you had close contact with from 48 hours before symptoms)
- You must also self-isolate if you have been in close contact with a confirmed COVID-19 case in the past 14 days; and/or you have returned from travel outside Canada in the past 14 days
