School Cash Online provides the following benefits:

- A convenient fee payment option that saves time
Reduces paper
No more need to send cash or cheques to school
A quick way to register. It takes less than 5 minutes to register.

Parents that opt to participate will receive notification via email of student fees owed (both required and optional), and can make secure online payments by credit card or Interac and receive a receipt.

Start by visiting the King City SS website and entering your email address to subscribe to email messages of a commercial nature. This must be the same email you use for your CashOnline Profile.

Timetable and locker information will be emailed home to parents and students after August 24 for those who have completed the on-line process.

Families needing assistance with this process may attend the school on Tuesday August 28 between 8:15 am and 11:15 am. Timetables and locker information will be emailed home later that day.

Step 1: Register

Please be sure to be using the most recent version of your web browser for links to work.

Click on the School Cash Online button on our school's website at http://kingcity.ss.yrdsb.ca/ Select the "Get Started Today" button. Complete each of the three Registration Steps

*For Security Reasons your password, requires 8 characters, one upper-case letter, one lowercase letter and a number.

Step 2: Confirmation Email

A registration confirmation email will be automatically forwarded to you. Click on the link provided inside the email to confirm your email and School Cash Online account. The confirmation link will open the School Cash Online site prompting you to sign into your account. Use your email address and password just created with your account.

Step 3: Find Student

NOTE: A STUDENT NUMBER IS REQUIRED (found on report card)

This step will connect your children to your account.

Enter the School Board Name
Enter the School Name
Enter Your Child's Student # and Last Name
Select Continue
On the next page confirm that you are related to the child, check in the Agree box and select Continue
Your child has been added to your account

Step 4: View Items or Add Another Student

If you have more children, select "Add Another Student" option and repeat the steps above. 5 children can be added to one parent account. If you do not wish to add additional children, select "View Items For Students" option. A listing of available items for purchase will be displayed.
