### **34 Credit Threshold**

- If needed, students may earn up to 34 credits within 5 years
- After secondary school, going beyond the 34 credit threshold is possible with e-learning, night school, summer school, adult day school, etc.
- 34 credit threshold does not apply...
  - if you have an Individual Education Plan (IEP)
  - to your first 4 years
  - to English as a Second Language (ESL) language courses

### University Admission Guidelines

•High school diploma required.

- •Six Grade 12 'U' or 'M' courses
- •most programs have 75% + admission averages.
- prerequisite courses for university programs are typically at the Gr. 12 'U/M' level.
- •consult university web sites, handbooks and "OUInfo".
- •Universities <u>may</u> consider Gr. 11 and 12 ('U' and 'M') courses for admission &/or prerequisites.
- Co-op credits do not count in university admission requirements or admission averages

### College Admission Guidelines

- •High school diploma with 12 "C" English
- •Additional requirements interview, portfolio, etc.
- •"C" &/or "M" type courses used for admission;
- Math and Science required for most Technology programs
- Applied degree programs have Gr 12 U and Mcourses as prerequisites
- Consult college handbooks/ website for specifics (OCAS)

In grades 9 & 10, only successfully completed courses appear on your transcript

In grades 11 & 12, a list of <u>ALL courses taken or</u> <u>attempted and not dropped by Full Disclosure</u>, will appear, with your mark, on your transcript

#### **Community Involvement**

- 40 hours needed to graduate
- Come to guidance to make sure your activity is eligible & get it pre-approved
- Opportunities available on the Guidance Office bulletin boards

### **Summer School Reminders**

- Reinforcement 2 weeks for students who were unsuccessful, and are approved by the credit recovery team
- Acceleration 4 weeks for students who have never taken the course before, or who were unsuccessful but did not meet the criteria for credit recovery (not available for grade 9 courses)
- Fill in "Interested in Summer School?" on My Pathway Planner in order to indicate interest in Summer School
