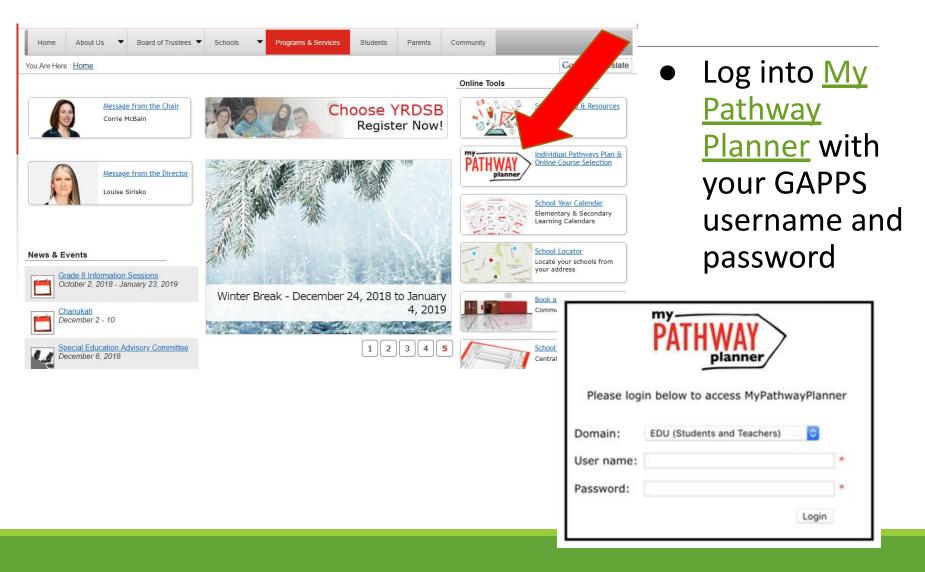

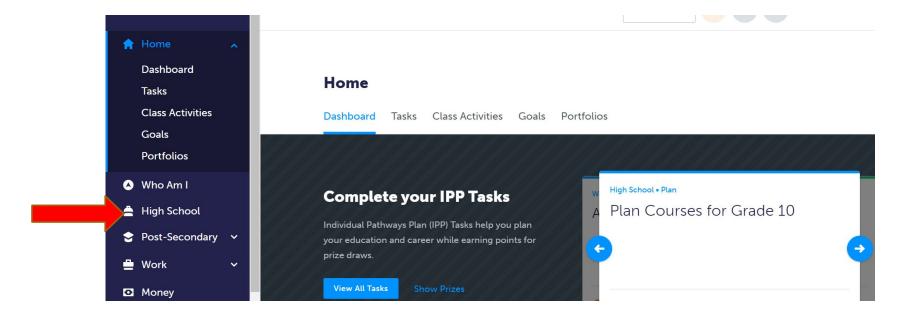


My Pathway Planner: Dashboard

 On your Dashboard, select High School to access your course planner




My Pathway Planner: Choosing Courses

 - + course to select from the courses offered at KCSS.




My Pathway Planner: If you are selecting Repertoire

My Pathway Planner: Alternate Courses




Please pick alternative courses.
